Executive Summary





The digital economy forecast & key highlights

A key driver of the digital economy growth in Africa is the digital commerce sector, which is projected to reach \$72 billion by 2026. This surge is largely attributed to the increasing adoption of online retail, accounting for 58% of digital transactions in major African markets as of 2023

Startups, organizations, freelancers and creatives should begin to plan ahead towards the Detty December surge and how they can plough into the opportunities there.

The African Advantage:

A young, innovative population with 60% of people under 25 years old, making it the youngest continent globally.

Rapidly expanding access to mobile technology, with smartphone penetration expected to surpass 500 million by 2025.

Increasing investment in digital infrastructure, with 5G, fiber, and satellite projects connecting remote regions.
